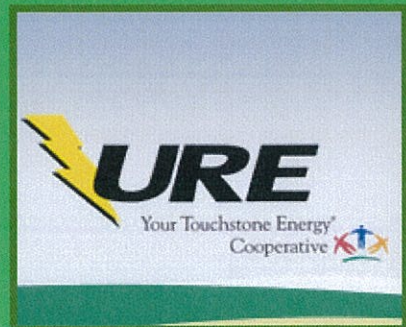

Sunburn Prevention!! (May's 2-for-1 Sub-Safety-Topic)

Avoid the sun between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Sun's rays are strongest, schedule outdoor activities other times, Seek shade, limit exposure time.

Cover up

Wear tightly woven clothing, cover arms/legs, broad-brimmed hat.

Use sunscreen frequently and liberally.

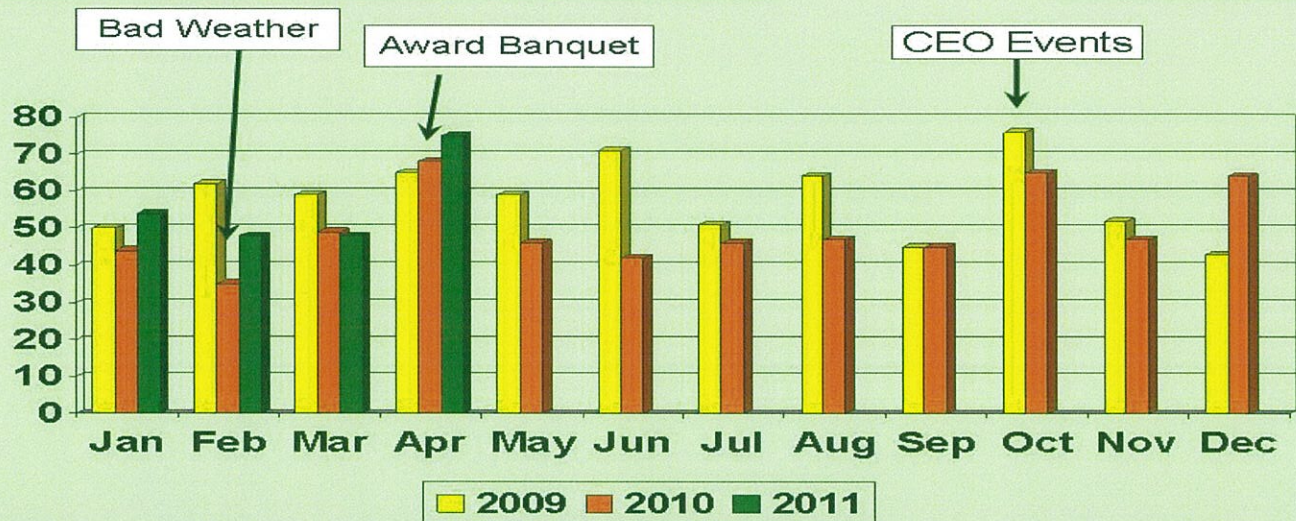
30 minutes before going out, reapply about every two hours — sooner if washed away, even on cloudy or hazy days. UV rays can penetrate cloud cover. (higher the UV the better)

Wear sunglasses.

Manufacturer's label = 99-100 % UV light, fit close to your face/wraparound frames
